3				The Order Response Id element is a unique number assigned to the OrderResponse by the Seller.	
4			1 BBIE	Indicates whether a document is a copy (true) or not (false)	
5			0..1 BBIE	a computer generated unique identifier for the document, which is guaranteed to be unique	
6			1 BBIE	a date (and potentially time) stamp denoting when the order response was issued.	
7			0..1 BBIE	Identifies the status of the document with regard to its original state	
8				contains any free form text pertinent to the entire document or to the document message itself. This element may contain notes or any other similar information that is not contained explicitly in another structure.	
9			1 BBIE	indicates whether the order was accepted (true) or not (false).	
10			0..1 BBIE	the reason for rejection if the order was not accepted.	"Out of Stock", "Not able to supply", "Unable to fulfill within the contracted conditions", "Buyer Account not Recognised"
11			1 ASBIE	associates the Order Response (Simple) with the Order it refers to.	
12			1 ASBIE	associates the Order with information about the buyer involved in the transaction.	
13			1 ASBIE	associates the Order with information about the seller involved in the transaction.
